### **EVENT INFORMATION:**

**GATE HOURS:** Access to the motor home and paddock area will be 2:00pm on Thursday. If you arrive prior to 2:00pm, you will be asked to wait in parking lot 3 until paddock access opens. The speedways main gate will remain open until 10:00 p.m. on Thursday. The main gate will reopen at 7:00am on Friday. Overnight camping in RV's is permitted. **Please bring your passes with you, or you will be charged \$10.00 at the gate.** We will have a will-call system in place for you to leave passes for family, friends or crew. Please write the names of the individuals on the back of the pass.

**GARAGES:** If you are assigned a garage space, the parking area directly across from your garage is your spot to park your rig and tow vehicle. **If you do not have an assigned garage, do not park in those spaces. If you park there you will be asked to move.**

There is no fueling or warming up engines in the garages allowed. You must push your car outside the garage for those tasks. This is the speedway rule!

**PARKING:** Please note the following areas are reserved: Parking areas adjacent to garage spaces are all reserved for those who have a garage as well as the area across from the Drivers Lounge at garage 2 is also reserved in both directions. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated. If you are not sure where to park ask before you unload.

**REGISTRATION** hours will be as follows: Thursday 3:00 pm – 6:00 pm, Friday 7:00am – 10:00am & Saturday 7:00am to 10:00am. **YOU MUST REGISTER BEFORE GOING ON TRACK.** Registration will be located in the sanctioning office, Garage 2. **Please make certain that you have a current medical on file or bring proof of a current medical to registration.**

**TECH:** You will find your tech sheet enclosed. Please check it to ensure your car number, class and group are correct. Some classes had name changes if you are not sure about your class please contact our Eligibility Chairman Jeff Ireland at [jireland@earthlink.net](mailto:jireland@earthlink.net) Please note: If your car number is highlighted on your tech sheet, that is the number that we are requesting that you use, do to a number conflict. If you have an annual tech for your car please bring your completed, signed, tech sheet along with your log book to registration. Your event tech sticker will be issued at registration if you have an annual tech. Otherwise Tech Inspection will begin at approx. 3:00 pm on Thursday in the Tech bay area located in Garage 2. Please enter from the East side of the garage, you will need your tech sheet, logbook, and driver gear including helmet.

**DRIVERS MEETING – MANDATORY 7:30 AM FRIDAY and 7:15AM SATURDAY. All drivers are required to attend the drivers meeting. Drivers meeting will happen in the Drivers Lounge, located in Garage 2, next to the VARA Credential Office.**

**FUEL AND TIRE SERVICE:** The fuel pumps will be open during certain hours throughout the weekend 100 and 110 octane will be available. Cash and Checks only, no credit cards or open account during the weekend. Further information will be available at registration regarding available fuel hours. Tire service will be available throughout the weekend thanks to Lynn Heaps of Topless Performance.

**VOLUNTEERS:** If you or a crew member can volunteer to help out, even 1 hour throughout the weekend, please contact the VARA office at 800 280-8272. This is a very labor-intensive event; your help would be greatly appreciated.

**MRO** will be available during the weekend and chapel service location & time will be announced at the drivers meeting Saturday morning.

**GROUND SCHOOL** will be held on Friday night at 6:00 pm at the track. Check in at registration for specific location and further details, or call the VARA office, 800-280-8272. **Ground school is mandatory for first time or unlicensed VARA drivers.** If you are not sure whether you need to attend ground school please contact our chief driving instructor Murray Chalmers at [mchalmers@pollybutte.net](mailto:mchalmers@pollybutte.net) or (951) 767-1296. Please note we are asking all 1<sup>st</sup> time drivers with VARA as well as Rookies to participate in the 3:00 on-track session on Friday.

**TRANSPONDERS:** If you would like to be included in the timing and scoring results, you must have a transponder. If you don't own one and you would like to rent a transponder, call the VARA office or ask about it at registration. There

may be one available that you can rent for \$ 40.00 for the weekend. A \$ 300.00 deposit is required upon receiving the rental transponder.

The deposit is returned to you on Sunday in exchange for the transponder.

**VARA'S INSURANCE UNDERWRITER POLICY FOR PADDOCK PERSONAL TRANSPORTATION VEHICLES: ALL OPERATORS MUST HAVE A VALID DRIVERS LICENSE. ALL VEHICLES MUST BE OPERATED IN A SAFE MANNER. PADDOCK SPEED IS 5 MPH. NO SKATEBOARDS, ROLLER BLADES OR NON-MOTORIZED SCOOTERS, ETC. AT ANYTIME.**

**KEEP YOUR PIT AREA CLEAN:** Please make sure to leave your pit area the way you found it, which will be spotless, Auto Club Speedway prides itself on being a first class facility. Please help to keep it that way. If you see trash lying around please help us by picking it up.

**SPEEDWAY RULES:** ***No Pets allowed.*** If you are caught with a pet, you will be asked to leave the facility! No testing of cars on speedway access roads. Speed limit signs must be observed. No fueling in the garages.
